The Scholarships

The institute awards a full-time PhD scholarship (1000 €/month) for up to three years. Interested PhD candidates can apply for the following topic:

Development of an Automatic Evaluation System of Match and Training Performance

The program is academically hosted by the **Institute of Sports & Preventive Medicine** & funded by the **German FA (DFB)**. The project will be conducted in close cooperation between both institutions & under supervision of **Prof. Tim Meyer**, **Christofer Clemens** (Head of DFB-Scouting & Match Analysis) and **Dr. Stephan Nopp** (Scientific consultant of the sporting director) will co-supervise from the DFB side.
